AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with HR Green, Inc. for design services for the McKinley Avenue Reconstruction Project (SW 9th Street – SW 14th Street), not to exceed \$365,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the PSA with HR Green, Inc. (Jason J. Poppen, President, 8710 Earhart Lane, Cedar Rapids, IA 52404), for a total cost not to exceed \$365,000, based on hourly rates, to provide professional services for the McKinley Avenue Reconstruction project.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Between 2008 and 2019, the City reconstructed McKinley Avenue between SE 14th Street and South Union Street from a rural roadway cross section to an urban roadway cross section with curbs and gutters, sidewalks on both sides, and storm sewer improvements.
- McKinley Avenue between South Union Street and SW 9th Street is planned for reconstruction in 2023 and 2024, converting the rural cross section to an urban cross section with curbs and gutters, a 10-feet-wide multi-use trail along the north side of the roadway and a 5-feet-wide sidewalk along the south side of the roadway, along with storm sewer improvements, and water main replacement by Des Moines Water Works.
- Currently, the section of McKinley Avenue between SW 9th Street and SW 14th Street varies in pavement width from 22 feet to 24 feet with no curbs and gutters and a 4-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of the roadway.
- MoveDSM identifies McKinley Avenue as a Community Residential Street, a street that connects neighborhoods together, and links residents to commercial nodes, parks and schools, as well as being on the core bicycle network.
- This project will include reconstructing McKinley Avenue between SW 9th Street and SW 14th Street to an urban cross-section with curbs and gutters, bicycle facility, sidewalks, and storm sewer where necessary. This project is scheduled for construction starting in 2025.

- A Request for Proposals (RFP) for design services was issued for design services and posted on the City's website. The City received 11 proposals in response to the RFP. The selection committee was comprised of representatives from the Engineering Department. HR Green, Inc. was selected based on their demonstrated understanding of the project, technical approach, design team qualifications, and experience with similar projects.
- Staff has negotiated a PSA with HR Green, Inc. for a total cost not to exceed \$365,000, based on hourly rates and reimbursable costs, to provide design phase services for the McKinley Avenue Reconstruction project between SW 9th Street and SW 14th Street.
- The scope of services includes project/contract management; project coordination; survey, data collection and subsurface utility investigations; conceptual design, design phase services; Des Moines Fire Department coordination, permitting assistance, public engagement activities, plan and specification preparation and bidding assistance.

ANTICIPATED ACTIONS AND FUTURE COMMITMENTS:

The City Council should anticipate future Council actions related to proceeding with construction of McKinley Avenue Reconstruction between SW 9th Street and SW 14th Street.
