AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of computer and accessory equipment from CDW Government LLC (200 N Milwaukee Avenue, Vernon Hills, IL 60061, Christine A. Leahy, President, and CEO) via the NASPO contract MNNVP-133 16055, Iowa PA 22206 and Omnia Agreement 2018011-01.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for the Information Technology (IT) Department to purchase computer and accessory equipment from CDW for replacement of existing computers using cooperative contracts pricing; NASPO contract MNNVP-133 16055, Iowa PA 22206 and Omnia Agreement 2018011-01, which are competitively bid. This continues the computer replacement process in order to bring equipment up to date and keeps the City network secure.
