AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2022 Sewer Lining Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Municipal Pipe Tool Company, LLC, Mark Kaler, Manager, \$2,945,436.19.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2022 Sewer Lining Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the rehabilitation of sanitary and storm sewers, including over 12,300 lineal feet of cured-in-place-pipe lining (trenchless sewer rehabilitation), 12 locations of sewer spot repairs/replacement, and three (3) manhole reconstructions and enlargements.

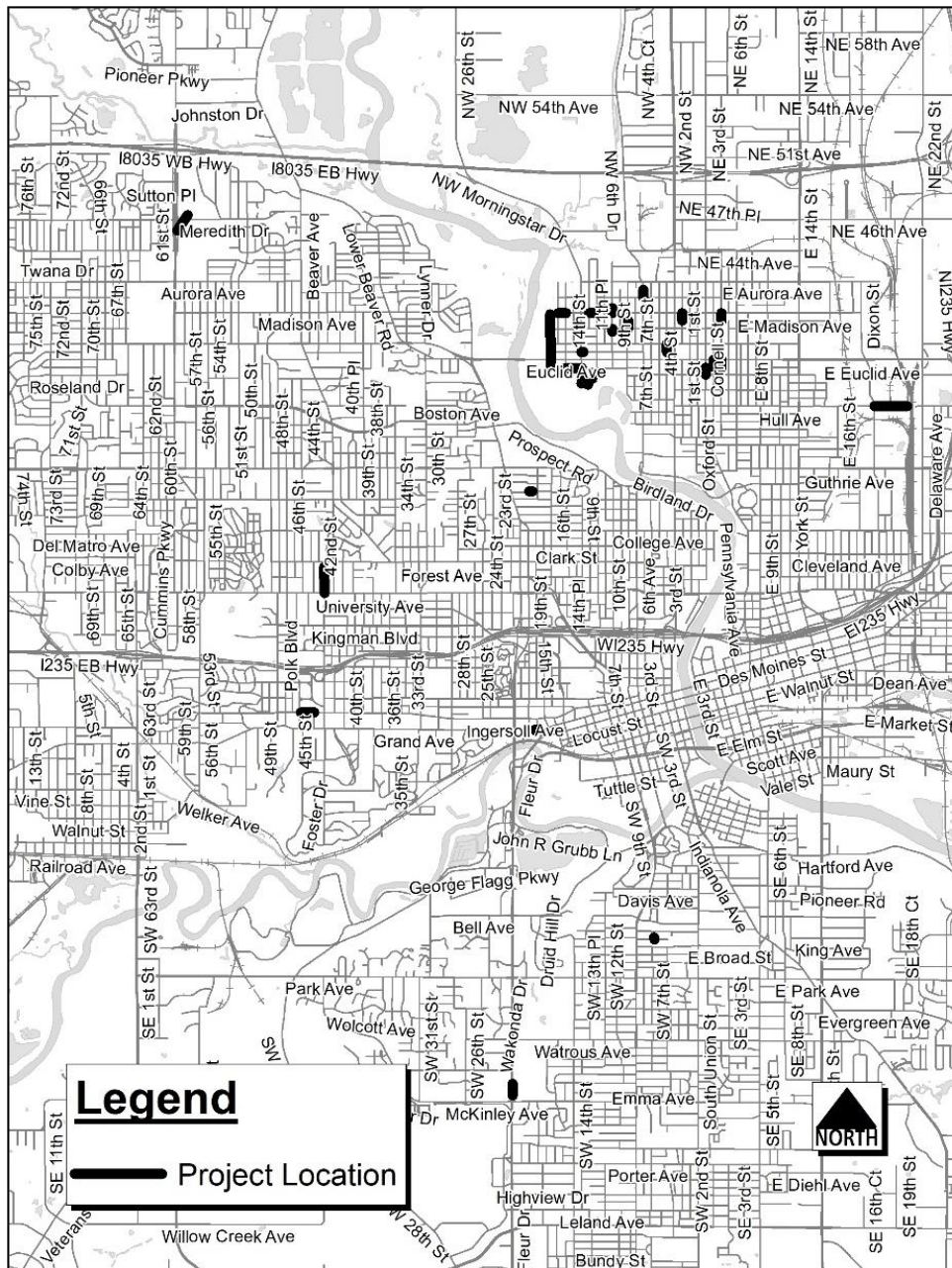

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On July 18, 2022, under Roll Call No. 22-1113, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2022 Sewer Lining Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2022 Sewer Lining Program, Activity ID 07-2022-007. The improvement includes the rehabilitation of approximately 12,000 lineal feet of 8-inch through 48-inch diameter sanitary sewers with cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining, bypass pumping, sewer cleaning and televising, sewer spot repairs, sewer spot lining, manhole rehabilitation, and other related items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Number 643-161/181, at the following locations: Fleur Drive, Grand Avenue, Ingersoll Avenue, 42nd Street, Allison Avenue, Ravina Drive, Waverly Drive, Riverview Drive, Oak Park Avenue, 16th Street, Clinton Avenue, Madison Avenue, 9th Street, 6th Avenue, 8th Street, 1st Street, Bowdoin Street, 3rd Street, Columbia Street, Cornell Street, Hull Avenue, Creston Avenue, and Meredith Drive, in Des Moines, Iowa.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - Municipal Pipe Tool Co., Inc., Hudson, IA - Low Bid
 - Visu-Sewer, Inc., Pewaukee, WI
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on August 9, 2022.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Municipal Pipe Tool Company, LLC, Mark Kaler, Manager, 515 5th Street, PO Box 398, Hudson, IA, 50643 in the amount of \$2,945,436.19, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
