## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

• The identified equipment is essential for effective emergency snow and ice control operations and is used to supplement the existing City fleet of owned equipment during emergency snow and ice control operations. The specific equipment that is rented and returned on a seasonal basis would have limited use during warm weather months and consists of heavy off-road equipment that has high acquisition and maintenance costs; therefore, seasonal rentals of needed equipment is the most cost-effective means to provide additional equipment during emergency snow and ice control operations.
