### AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding Traffic Regulation Changes as follows:

- A. Code correction—Update parking restriction to match field conditions on Mulberry Street at 8th Street.

Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

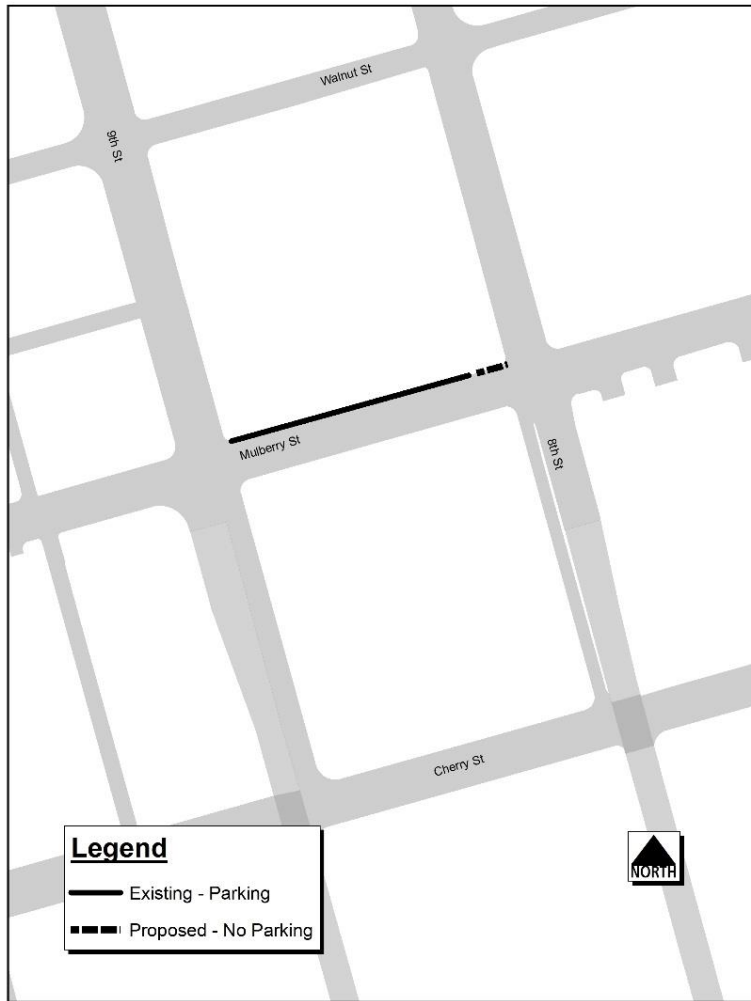
### FISCAL IMPACT:

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. As part of the efforts to enhance walkability at intersections as identified in the Connect Downtown Plan, curb extensions (bump outs) have been installed along Mulberry Street. As a result, parking spaces have been adjusted to match field conditions along this segment of Mulberry. The new curb extension at Mulberry Street and 8th Street resulted in a net change of one (1) less parking space on the north side of Mulberry Street from 8th Street to a point 40 feet west thereof, and the need to change the Municipal Code for this area of no parking. This proposed action will revise the Municipal Code to reflect the areas of no parking along Mulberry Street.



Sec. 114-3507. Mulberry Street—Eighth Street to Ninth Street.

Mulberry Street, on the north side from 8<sup>th</sup> Street to a point 40 feet west thereof, no parking any time.
