## AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding Traffic Regulation Changes as follows:

- A. Code change to match field conditions on the east and west sides of 7th Street between Grand Avenue and High Street.

Amount: Costs for sign installations and periodic maintenance of signs.

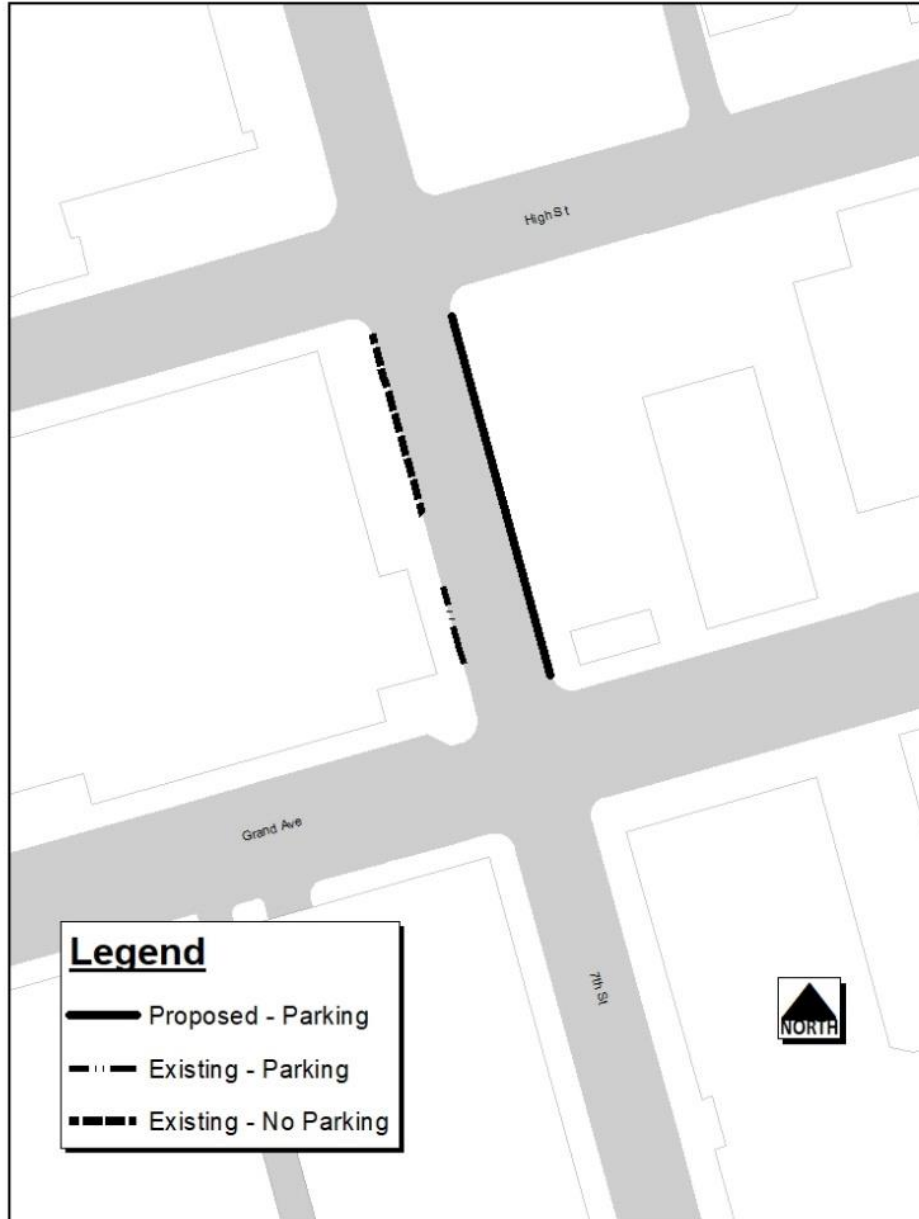

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. At the time the City's garage at 7th Street and Grand Avenue was demolished and the new Principal parking garage was built, the City's Municipal Code was not changed to match the new field conditions along the west side of 7th Street.

Additionally, due to the construction of a curb extension (bump-out) in the eastern curb lane of 7th Street just south of Grand Avenue, the parking restrictions on the east side of 7th Street between Grand Avenue and High Street are no longer needed and can be removed to provide for eight (8) new parking spaces.

The proposed action will revise the Municipal Code to reflect these changes.
