### AGENDA HEADING:

Request acceptance of the COPS Anti-Heroin grant through the Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy, designated to reimburse law enforcement overtime associated with mid to high-level heroin investigations.

### SYNOPSIS:

The Police Department requests approval to accept a grant award from the Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy in the amount of \$8,000 with a performance period of November 1, 2022, through September 30, 2024. The grant does not include a matching funds requirement. The award is directed to support the law enforcement investigation of heroin related cases.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$8,000 (revenue)

Funding Source: Special Revenues and Other Funding Page 200 of the Adopted Operating Budget, Department Detail for Fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The grant funds offered by the Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy are dedicated to the reimbursement of officer overtime spent on heroin related cases between November 1, 2022, and September 30, 2024. The funds are provided to assist with mid to high-level heroin investigations. Information will be shared with other agencies through the Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN).
