AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Pennsylvania Avenue Rehabilitation from E. Washington to E. Jefferson: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as MPS Engineers, PC d/b/a Kingston Services, PC (Umesh G. Shetye, President), \$304,213.75.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Pennsylvania Avenue Rehabilitation from E. Washington to E. Jefferson and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for rehabilitation of Pennsylvania Avenue roadway pavement from E. Washington Avenue to E. Jefferson Avenue including milling the existing pavement surface and overlaying with a new Hot-Mix Asphalt (HMA) surface. This project also includes replacement of the existing sidewalk with a new 10-foot-wide multiuse trail along the west side of Pennsylvania Avenue from E. Washington Avenue to E. Jefferson Avenue.

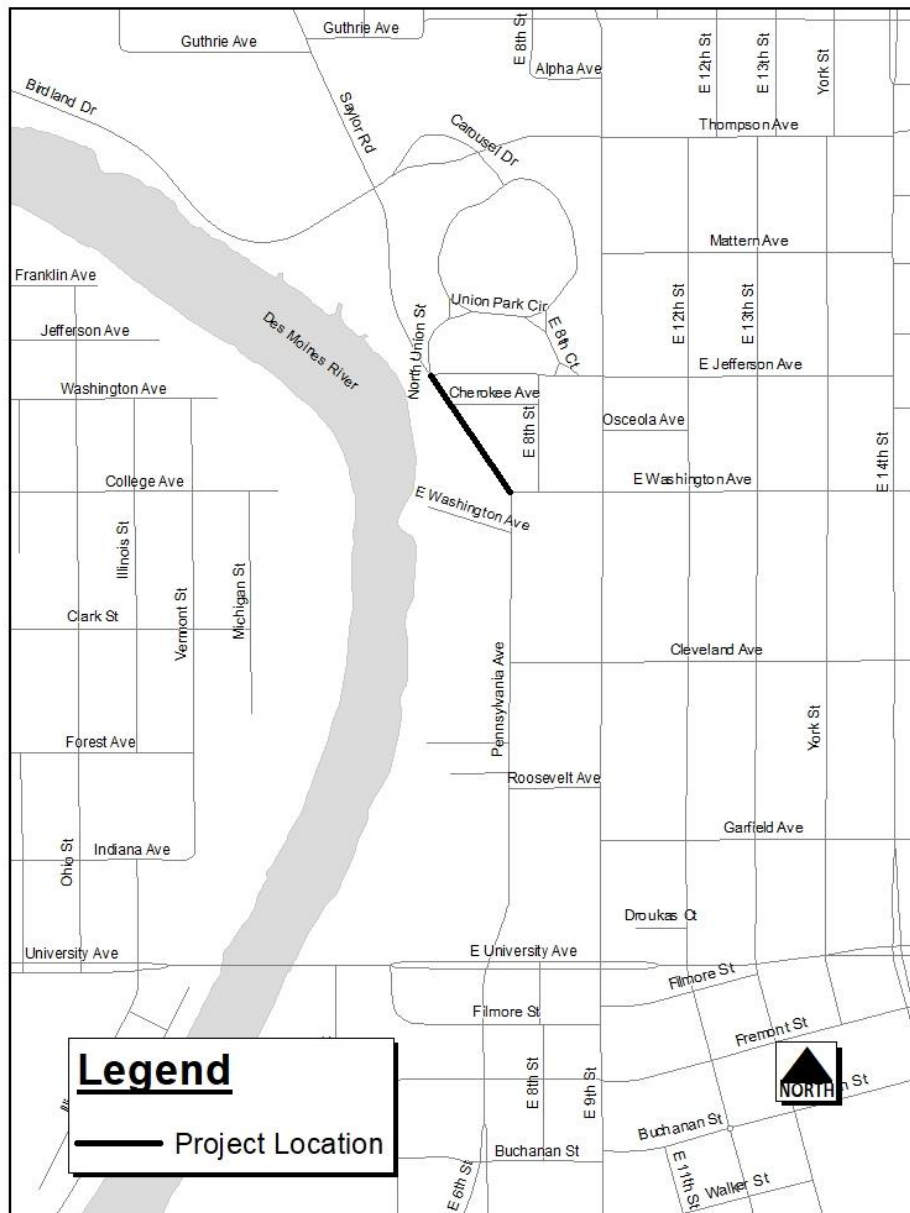

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On January 9, 2023, under Roll Call No. 23-0008, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Pennsylvania Avenue Rehabilitation from E. Washington to E. Jefferson. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Pennsylvania Avenue Rehabilitation from E. Washington to E. Jefferson, Activity ID 06-2023-004. The improvements include Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) curb and gutter, milling 2-inch HMA paving, PCC trail, PCC driveways, earthwork and grading, pavement markings, water services, erosion control, restoration, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 648-218/246, located along Pennsylvania Avenue from E. Washington Avenue to E. Jefferson Avenue.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - MPS Engineers, P.C. d/b/a Kingston Services, P.C., Des Moines, IA - Low Bid
 - TK Concrete, Inc., Pella, IA
 - Caliber Concrete, LLC, Adair, IA
 - Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Newton, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa, at 11:00 a.m. on January 24, 2023.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by MPS Engineers, P.C. d/b/a Kingston Services, P.C. (Umesh G. Shetye, President, 1444 Illinois Street, Des Moines, Iowa, 50314), in the amount of \$304,213.75, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project will start after June 3, 2023, to accommodate the Dam to Des Moines half marathon event and will be completed in fall 2023.
