AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2023 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Resurfacing Program Contract 1: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Timothy Mallicoat, President, \$955,593.95.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2023 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1 and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for resurfacing of roadways utilizing surface scarification and HMA overlay to improve the surface condition and to extend the useful service life of the streets.

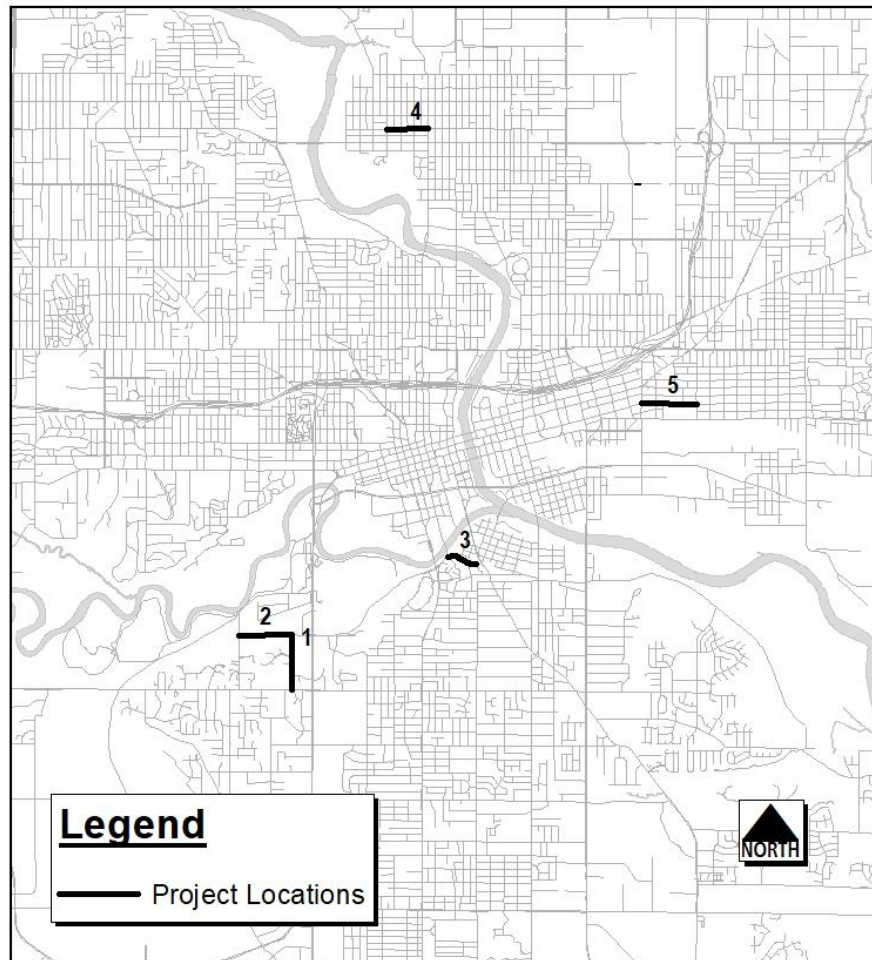
Amount: \$955,593.95 construction contract (\$1,200,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On January 23, 2023, under Roll Call No. 23-0086, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2023 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2023 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1, Activity ID 062022007. The improvements include scarification of existing asphalt streets, furnish and place HMA, furnish and place pavement markings, traffic control and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 652-157/196, at the following locations and other locations in the City as directed by the Engineer:
 - SW 23rd Street - Bell Avenue to Park Avenue
 - Bell Avenue - SW 23rd Street to SW 30th Street
 - Indianola Road - South Union Street to SW 7th Street
 - Douglas Avenue - 6th Avenue to 11th Street
 - E Walnut Street - E 18th Street to E 22nd Street

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA - Low Bid
 - InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA
 - OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA - Bid not read (bid bond submitted was for a different project)
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on February 7, 2023.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation (Timothy Mallicoat, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313), in the amount of \$955,593.95, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2023 and be completed in the summer of 2024. Work on the SW 23rd Street and Indianola Road locations will be completed during summer break while school is not in session.
