AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Joint Public Service Agreement with the City of Norwalk for Construction of Traffic Signals at the Intersection of Highway 5 and Highway 28.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval and authorization to execute the 28E Agreement between Norwalk and the City of Des Moines for the construction of traffic signal at the eastbound exit ramp from Highway 5 to Highway 28 in Norwalk, Warren County.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$125,000

Funding Source: 2023-2024 CIP, Page 180, Traffic & Pedestrian Signals – New, TR102, G.O. Bonds

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Des Moines and Norwalk share a common municipal boundary at the intersection of Highway 28 and Highway 5. The signal at the westbound exit ramp, located within Des Moines, was included as part of the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) construction. Due to increasing traffic in the area, improved traffic control is needed at the intersection. A traffic signal at the eastbound ramp would accomplish this.
- Norwalk will manage the construction of the signals and all future maintenance. Construction will include interconnecting to the Des Moines signals in the area.
- The estimated project cost of \$500,000 is to be split, as follows: Des Moines to contribute 25%, up to \$125,000; IDOT to contribute 55%, up to \$200,000; and Norwalk is responsible for remaining costs.
