AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding Traffic Regulation Changes as follows:

- A. Parking Modification - 7th Street between Walnut Street and Locust Street; and on Walnut Street between 7th Street and 8th Street.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes. Costs for sign installations and periodic maintenance of signs.

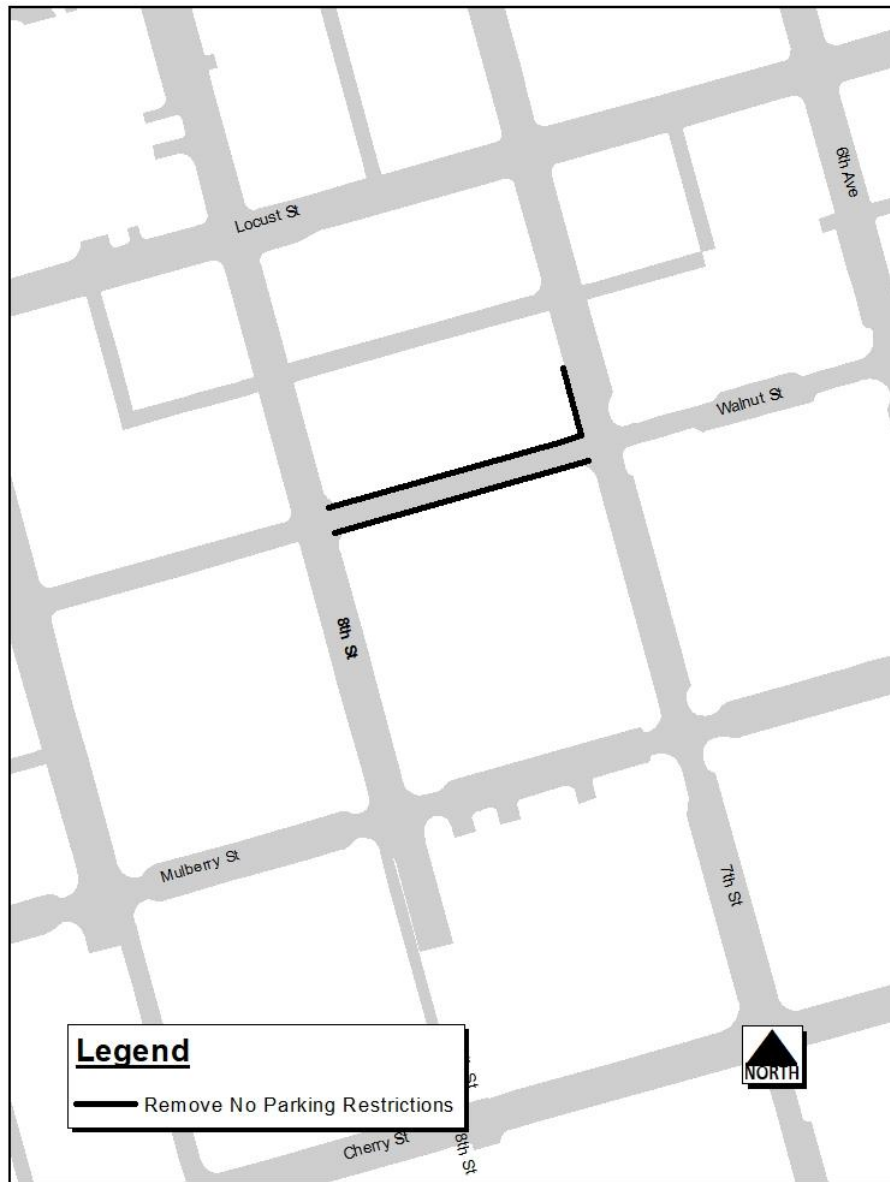

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. With the completion of the new EMC Urban Park on the northwest corner of 7th Street and Walnut Street, modifications in the Municipal Code along both streets are necessary. The recommended action will remove existing parking restrictions on the west side of 7th Street, north of Walnut Street, and on both sides of Walnut Street between 7th Street and 8th Street to allow on-street metered parking spaces to be installed. During field review, it was found that the signage for a loading zone on the westside of 7th Street, just south of Locust Avenue had apparently been moved because of prior streetscape work. Therefore, the Municipal Code needs to be corrected to match field conditions for this loading zone. The following revisions to the Municipal Code will place the recommended changes into effect and correct for field conditions.



Sec. 114-2663. Seventh Street--Walnut Street to Locust Street.

Seventh Street, on the west side, from a point ~~62~~65 feet south of Locust Street to a point 50 feet south thereof, loading zone.

~~Seventh Street, on the west side, from a point 112 feet south of Locust Street to a point 51 feet south thereof, no parking any time.~~

~~Seventh Street, on the west side, from a point 163 feet south of Locust Street to Walnut Street, no parking any time.~~

Sec. 114-3738. Walnut Street--Seventh Street to Eighth Street.

~~Walnut Street, on both sides, from Seventh Street to Eighth Street, no parking any time.~~
