AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 4 to the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with Kirkham Michael & Associates, Inc. for additional professional services for Ingersoll Avenue Streetscape (31st Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway), for an amount not to exceed \$211,270.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 4 to the PSA with Kirkham Michael & Associates, Inc. (Michael S. Olson, P.E., President, 12700 West Dodge Road, Omaha, Nebraska) for an additional amount not to exceed \$211,270, based on hourly labor rates and reimbursable costs, to provide construction phase services for Phase 4 of the Ingersoll Avenue Streetscape Project which includes the south half of Ingersoll Avenue from 31st Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway.

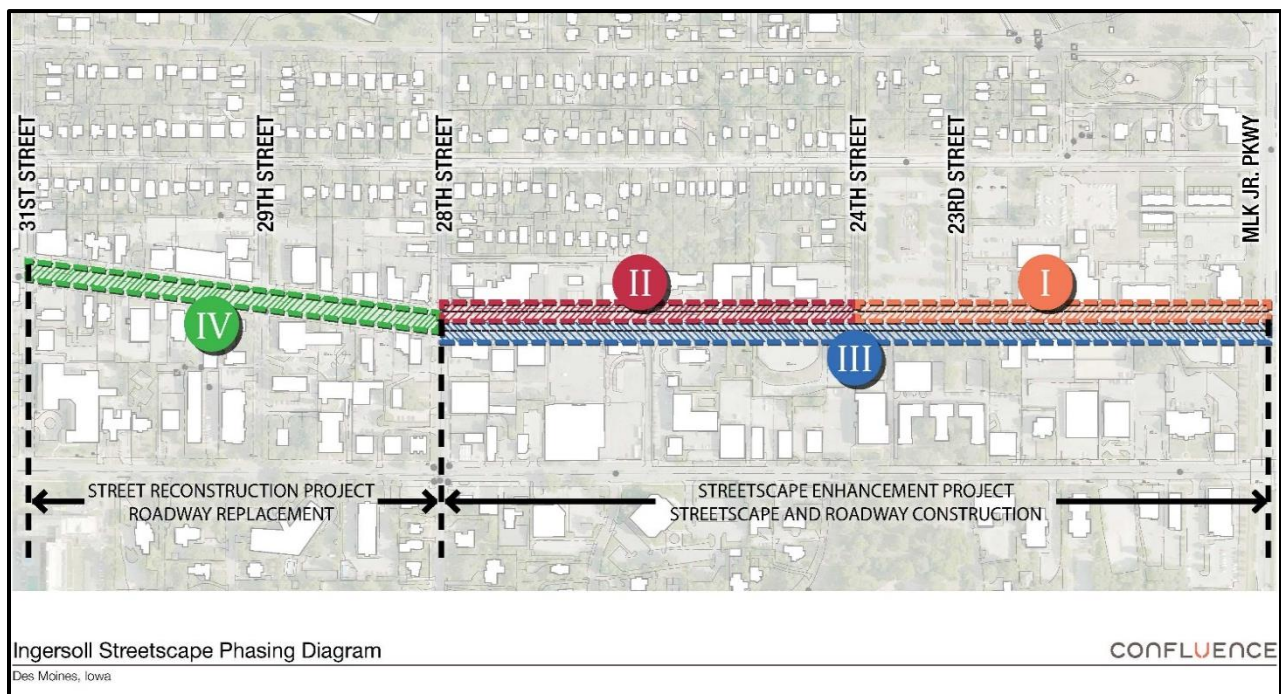

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Ingersoll Avenue Streetscape project from MLK Parkway to 31st Street is being constructed in the following four (4) phases over a period of five (5) years starting with Phase 1 construction that began in 2020.
 - Phase 1: North half of Ingersoll Avenue from Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway to 24th Street (Complete).
 - Phase 2: North half of Ingersoll Avenue from 24th Street to 28th Street (Complete).
 - Phase 3: South half of Ingersoll Avenue from Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway to 28th Street (Complete).
 - Phase 4 (street reconstruction only): Ingersoll Avenue from 28th Street to 31st Street (scheduled to start construction in 2024 and be completed in 2025).

- On January 4, 2019, by Roll Call No. 19-0016, City Council approved the PSA with Kirkham Michael & Associates, Inc. for a total cost not to exceed \$525,000, to provide preliminary design for the entire corridor from 31st Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and final design for Phase 1 of the Ingersoll Avenue Streetscape Improvements Project.
- On May 4, 2020, by Roll Call No. 20-0734, City Council approved Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Kirkham Michael & Associates, Inc. for an additional amount not to exceed \$450,000, to provide final design and letting phase services for Phase 2 and construction phase services for Phase 1 of the Ingersoll Avenue Streetscape Improvements Project.
- On December 21, 2020, by Roll Call No. 20-2085, City Council approved Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Kirkham Michael & Associates, Inc. for an additional amount not to exceed \$485,000, to provide final design and letting phase services for Phase 3 and construction phase services for Phase 2 of the Ingersoll Avenue Streetscape Improvements Project.
- On December 6, 2021, by Roll Call No. 21-1794, City Council approved Supplemental Agreement No. 3 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Kirkham Michael & Associates, Inc. for an additional amount not to exceed \$436,000, to provide final design and letting phase services for Phase 4 and construction phase services for Phase 3 of the Ingersoll Avenue Streetscape Improvements Project.
- Staff has negotiated Supplemental Agreement No. 4 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Kirkham Michael & Associates, Inc. for an additional amount not to exceed \$211,270, based on hourly rates and reimbursable costs, to provide construction phase services including construction administration, construction observation, and construction staking services for Phase 4 of the Ingersoll Avenue Streetscape Improvements Project.
