AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the proposition to authorize and enter into a purchase agreement in the principal amount not-to-exceed \$1,500,080 for the purpose of purchasing upgraded in-car video systems with installation, implementation, and video evidence management software from Motorola Solutions Inc. (500 W. Monroe Street, Suite 4400, Chicago, IL 60661, Greg Brown, CEO) utilizing the Sourcewell Contract.

SYNOPSIS:

Approval of the purchase of upgraded in-car video systems with installation and evidence video management software for the Police Department. This purchase would replace all current devices with new enhanced cameras for high resolution video. The video evidence management software will assist with the integration of body worn camera video and automate the uploading of the video file from the field to improve time efficiency.

Amount: \$1,500,080 over the course of five (5) years which includes the five (5)-year extended service and warranty agreement

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Police Department currently uses a model of in-car video equipment that has reached the end of supported life. The requested replacement is a new model designed around a high-power processing core with enhanced 4K camera functions. The proposed system is compatible with the current body worn cameras as well as other computer systems currently used in police vehicles. The video evidence management software included in the purchase will integrate the videos from both the body worn camera and in-car system to create a single encrypted file which automatically uploads from the field. This capability will allow the complete video file of an event to be readily available and easily located. The debt financing agreement includes the five (5)-year extended service and warranty agreement.
