AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2024 HMA Residential Paving Program Contract 1 - Receiving bids, (3-19-24), and Setting date of hearing, (4-15-24). (Construction Estimate - \$755,000).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the paving of residential streets utilizing surface scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) to extend the useful service life of streets. The project also includes constructing Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant sidewalk curb ramps, and removal and replacement of Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) curb and gutter sections within the project locations.

Amount: \$755,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page 112, Roadway Rehabilitation – Residential, ST013, G.O. Bonds

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2024 HMA Residential Paving Program Contract 1, Activity ID 06-2024-004. The improvement includes furnishing labor, equipment, and materials for the removal of existing HMA pavement and surfacing materials by milling/scarifying to an average depth of four (4) inches and six (6) inches, prepare subgrade/subbase, reconstruct streets with four (4) inches of HMA pavement with two (2) lifts, construct one (1)-inch HMA pavement overlay for cemetery entrance, replace sections of PCC curb and gutter, and replace existing sidewalk ramps with ADA-compliant ramps, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations and other locations as directed by the City Engineer within the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

- E. 29th Street from Dean Avenue to E. Walnut Street
 - Bowdoin Street from E. Shawnee Avenue to E. Aurora Avenue
 - Columbia Street from E. Shawnee Avenue to E. Aurora Avenue
 - Amherst Street from E. Seneca Avenue to Dead End North
 - E. Seneca Avenue from Amherst Street to E. 8th Street
 - E. 8th Street from E. Douglas Avenue to E. Madison Avenue
 - McCormick Street from E. University Avenue to Cleveland Avenue
 - SW 59th Street from Tonka Avenue to North Valley Drive
 - Masonic Cemetery entrance west of 48th Street and College Avenue
- The estimated construction cost is \$755,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
 - Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in spring 2024 and be completed in fall 2024.

Construction work on the following location shall be completed before June 15, 2024.

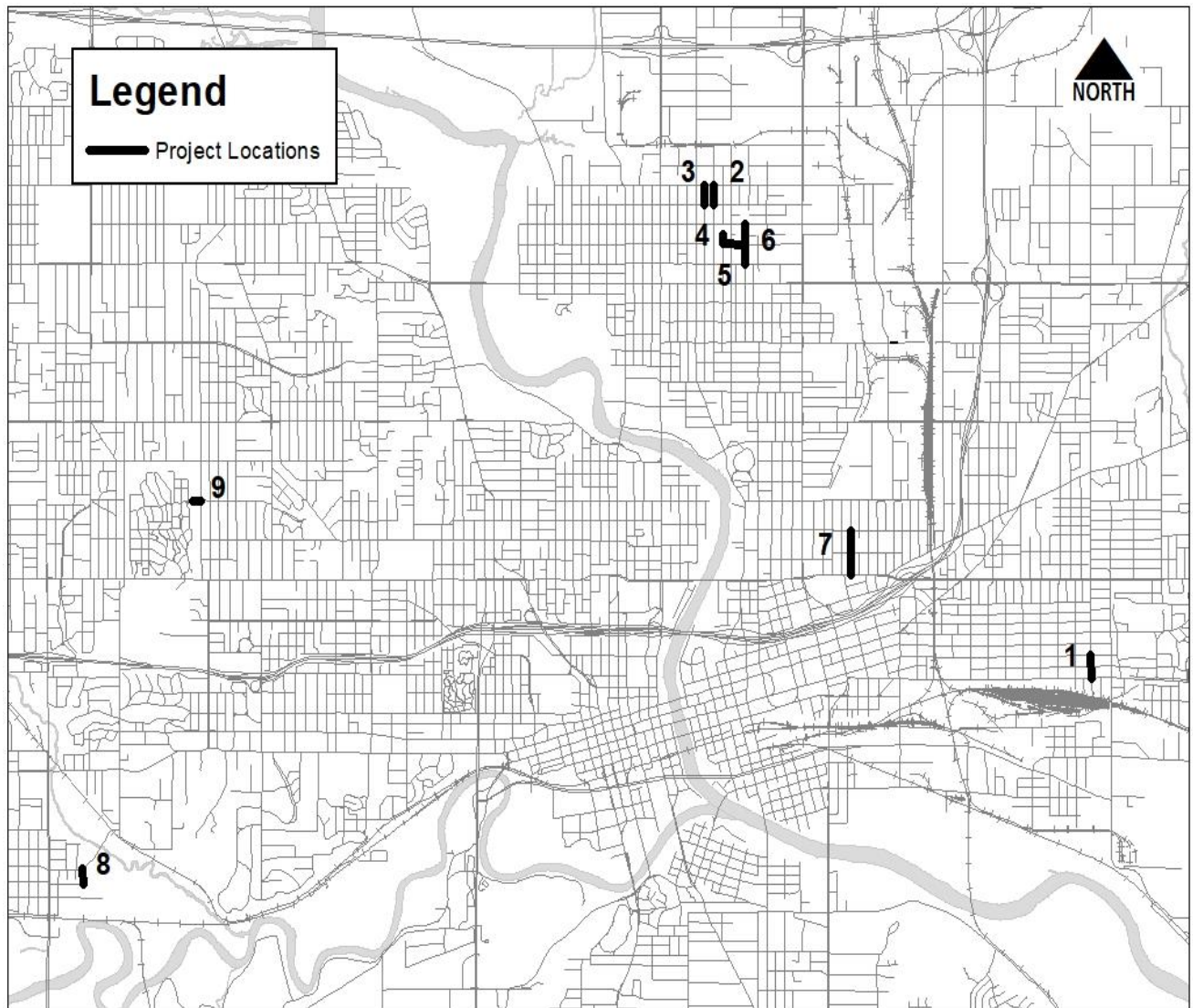
- Masonic Cemetery entrance west of 48th Street and College Avenue

Construction work on the following location shall be completed before July 31, 2024.

- E. 29th Street from Dean Avenue to E. Walnut Street

Construction work on the following three (3) locations shall be completed between June 5, 2024, and August 11, 2024, while school is out of session.

- E. Seneca Avenue from Amherst Street to E. 8th Street
- E. 8th Street from E. Douglas Avenue to E. Madison Avenue
- McCormick Street from E. University Avenue to Cleveland Avenue
