AGENDA HEADING:

- A. Parking Modifications – Ingersoll Avenue from 31st Street to Crescent Drive

Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes. Costs for sign installations and periodic maintenance of signs.

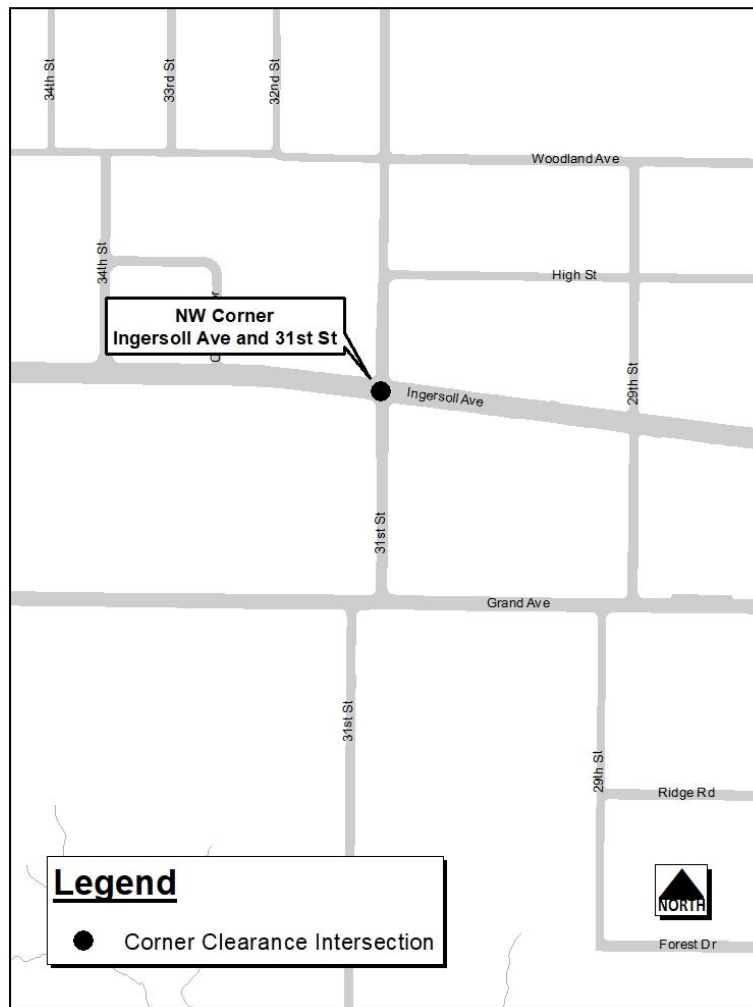

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. As part of the upcoming Ingersoll Streetscape Improvements from 28th Street to 31st Street, the existing westbound Ingersoll Avenue DART stop east of 31st Street will be relocated to the west side of the 31st Street intersection. The proposed code modification will extend the existing no parking corner clearance by 18 feet to allow enough space to relocate the bus stop to the northwest corner of the intersection. The following revisions to the Municipal Code are necessary to place the recommended changes into effect.



Sec. 114-3344. Ingersoll Avenue--Twenty-eighth Street to Thirty-fifth Street.

Ingersoll Avenue, on the north side, from a point 170 feet east of Thirty-first Street to a point 4058 feet west of Thirty-first Street, no parking any time.
