## AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2024 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Resurfacing Program Contract 1: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Jeffry Rasmussen, President, \$1,005,601.50.

## SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2024 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1 and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the resurfacing of roadways, utilizing surface scarification and HMA overlay to improve the surface condition and to extend the useful service life of the streets.

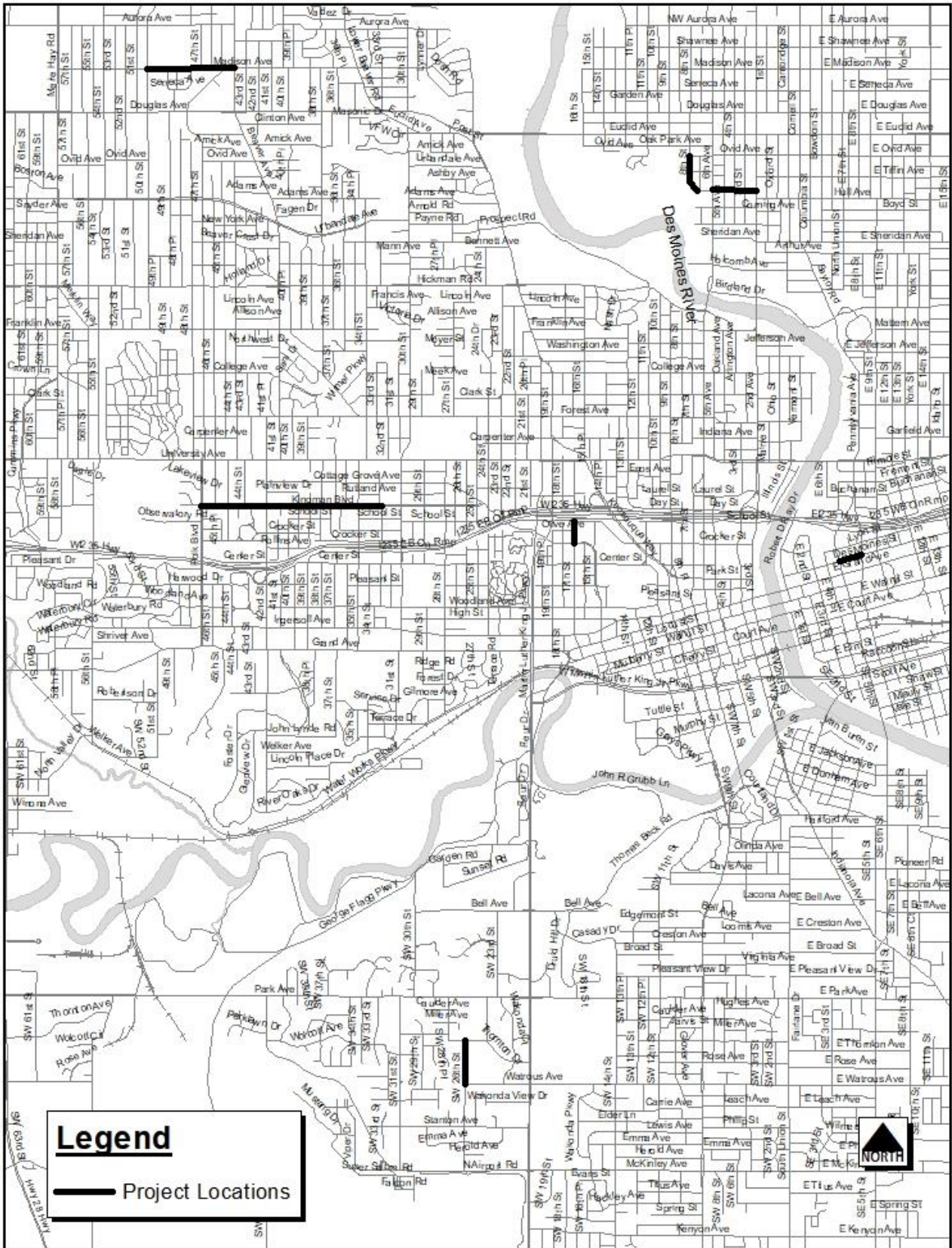
Amount: \$1,005,601.50 Construction Contract (\$1,200,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On May 6, 2024, under Roll Call No. 24-0639, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2024 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2024 HMA Resurfacing Program Contract 1, Activity ID 06-2024-002. The improvement includes scarification of existing asphalt streets, furnish and place HMA, furnish and place pavement markings, traffic control and other incidental items, all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File No. 663-070/100, at the following locations and other locations directed by the City Engineer:
  - 8th Street - Boston Avenue to Ovid Avenue
  - 17th Street - Crocker Street to School Street

- SW 26th Street - Thornton Avenue to Watrous Avenue
  - Boston Avenue - 2nd Avenue to 6th Avenue
  - Des Moines Street - East 6th Street to Pennsylvania Avenue
  - Kingman Boulevard - Polk Boulevard to 33rd Street
  - Madison Avenue - Beaver Avenue to 50th Street
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
    - Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA – Low Bid
    - OMG Midwest, Inc. dba Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
    - InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA
  - The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, IA at 11:00 a.m. on May 21, 2024.
  - The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Jeffrey Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA 50313 in the amount of \$1,005,601.50, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
  - Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in spring 2024 and be completed in fall 2024, except that the following three (3) locations shall be completed before August 9, 2024, in order to avoid impacting schools while they are in session:
    - SW 26th Street - Thornton Avenue to Watrous Avenue
    - 17th Street - Crocker Street to School Street
    - Madison Avenue - Beaver Avenue to 50th Street
