## AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2024 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Rural Paving Program – Local Option Sales and Service Tax (LOSST): Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Jeffry Rasmussen, President, \$456,744.

## SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2024 HMA Rural Paving Program – LOSST and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the resurfacing of various residential streets with rural pavement cross sections (no curbs and gutters) utilizing surface scarification and HMA to extend the useful service life of streets.

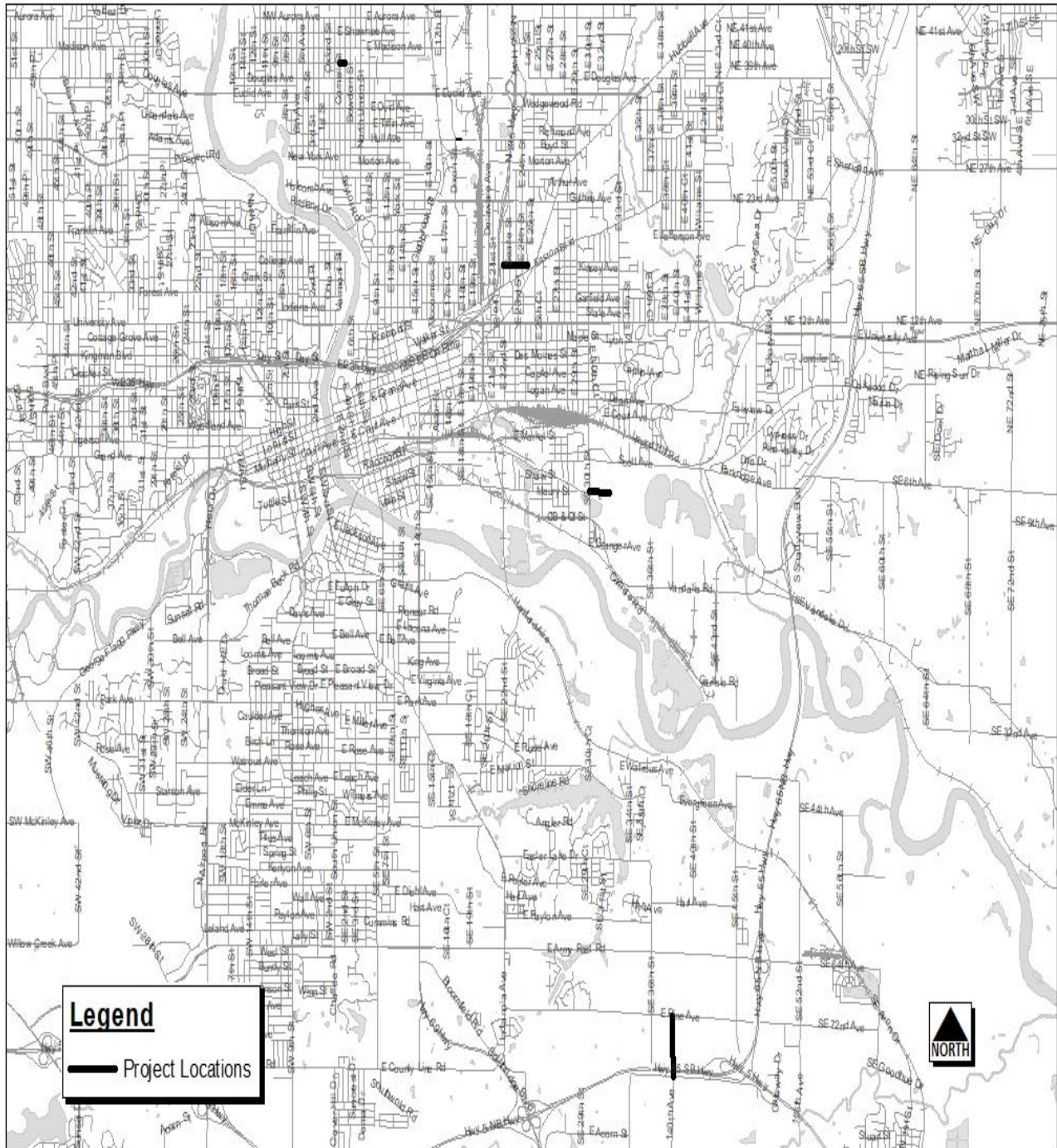

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On April 15, 2024, under Roll Call No. 24-0555, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2024 HMA Rural Paving Program – LOSST. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2024 HMA Rural Paving Program – LOSST, Activity ID 06-2024-012. The improvement includes furnishing labor, equipment, and materials for the removal of existing HMA pavement and surfacing materials by milling/scarifying to an average depth of four (4) inches, prepare subgrade/subbase, repave streets with four (4) inches of HMA pavement consisting of two, two (2)-inch thick lifts, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations and other locations as directed by the City Engineer:
  - S.E. 38th Street from County Line Road to E. Pine Avenue
  - E. Washington Avenue from E. 22nd Street to Lay Street

- Maury Street from S.E. 30th Street to dead end east
- E. Seneca Avenue from Cornell Street to Columbia Street
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
  - Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA - Low Bid
  - InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA
  - Parking Lot Specialties, LLC, Carlisle, IA
  - OMG Midwest, Inc. dba Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, IA, at 11:00 a.m. on May 7, 2024.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation (Jeffrey Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA 50313) in the amount of \$456,744, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in summer 2024 and be completed in fall 2024, except that all work on the E. Washington Avenue location shall be completed between June 5, 2024, and August 11, 2024, while school is out of session.
