AGENDA HEADING:

Requesting approval of sole source purchase of bituminous material in the amount of \$500,000.

SYNOPSIS:

The Department of Public Works uses multiple products from Bituminous Materials and Supply, L.P., including but not limited to products for pothole patching and surface sealing in the amount of \$500,000 annually with four (4) one (1)-year renewals.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$500,000

<u>Funding Source</u>: Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2025 Operating Budget, Public Works Department, S360, PW240402

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Asphaltic tack is required to allow hot mix asphalt to bond with cold asphalt. This allows overlays and patch material to hold to the existing pavement.
- Microsurfacing is a preventative maintenance treatment used to extend the service life of a street five (5) to seven (7) years. It is used to fill ruts and low to moderate distress and narrow cracks on a roadway. The asphaltic material used in microsurfacing is provided by Bituminous Materials and Supply, L.P.
- Bituminous Materials and Supply, L.P. is the only supplier of bituminous materials in Central Iowa. They also have a plant in Tama, Iowa, which supplies the material for microsurfacing. The microsurfacing material has a shelf-life preventing shipping from other states.
