AGENDA HEADING:

Approving instructor agreement with Siricasso Garcia for class instruction for City of Des Moines Recreation Program.

SYNOPSIS:

Staff recommend approval of an agreement between the City of Des Moines and Siricasso Garcia for the purpose of instructing Brews and Brushes at the City-owned Captain Roy's on Saturday, August 3, 2024.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City of Des Moines Parks and Recreation Department is dedicated to providing recreation programming to meet the needs and interests of all our community members. In an effort to expand programming choices to meet this goal, staff desire to offer programming for a special event involving painting instruction, Brews and Brushes, at Captain Roy's on August 3, 2024.
- Brews and Brushes is a social event where participants gather to enjoy painting and their favorite beverage. Participants will receive step-by-step instructions from a professional artist, making it suitable for both beginners and experienced painters.
- Siricasso Garcia will provide class instruction and all necessary materials. The City will provide the facility, Captain Roy's.
- The instructor will receive 70% of the revenue from registration fees and the City will receive the remaining 30%, for a one (1)-year term and any renewals.

- The City Parks and Recreation Department Director would be authorized to consider, approve, and execute future instructor agreements for this and similar department programs, whether the instructor is to be compensated for services or whether such services are provided on a volunteer basis, following approval as to form by the Legal Department.
