Approving the Fiscal Year 2024 annual Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification report.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification Report for FY24. This annual report is a requirement for the Police Department's participation in the sharing of federal asset forfeiture funds and has been prepared for submission to the Department of Justice (DOJ) who administers the program.

Amount: Revenue varies from year to year depending on the activity. In FY24, the revenue from forfeited funds generated was \$106,916.38. The Police Department expended \$106,104.90 to attend various job-related training and instruction throughout the year

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This report verifies proper use of the federal asset forfeiture funds in accordance with the DOJ rules and regulations for equitable sharing for local law enforcement agencies. Funds may not be used to replace or supplant the budgeted resources of the law enforcement agency.
