AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of one (1) Regenerative Air replacement Street Sweepers for use by the Street Cleaning Division for the Department of Public Works.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommending the purchase of one (1) replacement Regenerative Air System Street Sweeper for use by the Street Cleaning Division for the Department of Public Works. Utilizing Sourcewell contract number 111522-TYM in the amount of \$393,939.00 to Tymco Inc. Equipment (Keneth J. Young, President/CEO, 225 Industrial East, Waco Texas 76705).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

One (1) existing street sweeper exceeding replacement criteria was approved by the Fleet Oversight Committee (FOC) for replacement in the five (5) year replacement plan beginning in FY2023-2024. Street sweepers are utilized in multiple shift operations to maintain the minimum standards necessary for street cleaning with a fleet of 11 total machines.

The recommended award is for a truck chassis mounted regenerative air sweeper. The purchase of a single unit will be used to test the effectiveness of a regenerative air technology. A Tymco Regenerative Air Sweeper uses a controlled blast of air to dislodge debris from the surface. All debris picked up by the pick-up head is directed up the large diameter heavy duty suction hose into the hopper. TYMCO removes trash, dirt and fines from the entire area beneath the full-width pick-up head. Regenerative Air means a TYMCO never exhausts polluted air into the atmosphere like a vacuum sweeper. The unit will be delivered and warranted by the local dealership Mid-Iowa Solid Waste.
