AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 9th & Locust Parking Garage Elevator Improvements: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Lloyd Construction Company, Chris Thorkelson, President, \$751,500.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 9th & Locust Parking Garage Elevator Improvements and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The project will modernize two (2) electric overhead geared traction passenger elevators in the northwest corner of the garage, mechanical improvements in the elevator penthouses in the northwest and southeast corners of the garage. The potential add-alternate included in the original bidding documents is not being selected for this project.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• On September 16, 2024, under Roll Call No. 24-1213, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 9th & Locust Parking Garage Elevator Improvements. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 9th & Locust Parking Garage Elevator Improvements, Activity ID 04-2020-010. The improvement includes the modernization of two (2) seven (7)-stop, electric overhead geared traction passenger elevators located in one (1) shared hoistway in the northwest corner of the 9th & Locust Parking Garage, mechanical improvements in the elevator penthouses in the northwest and southeast corners of the garage, and all associated electrical improvements, all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File No. 668-210/232, located at the 9th & Locust Parking Garage, 801 Locust Street. The potential add-alternate included in the original bidding documents is not being selected for this project.

- A sealed bid for said improvement was submitted by the following bidder:
 - o Lloyd Construction Company, Sioux Falls, SD Low Bid
- The bid was received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, IA at 11:00 a.m. on October 8, 2024.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Lloyd Construction Company (Chris Thorkelson, President, 150 East 4th Place, Suite 600, Sioux Falls, SD 57104) in the amount of \$751,500, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to be completed by fall 2025.
