AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code to correct or update certain definitions.

SYNOPSIS:

The proposed amendment to the Municipal Code Chapter 114 corrects or updates specific definitions to reflect revisions from prior amendments to the Municipal Code or current processes and operations of the City.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The following definitions found in Chapter 114-1 do not adhere to current language found elsewhere in the Municipal Code approved by the City Council through prior amendments or the current processes or operations in the City. The following modifications to the Municipal Code will place these changes into effect.
 - Parking meter means and includes any mechanical device or multi-space meter not inconsistent with this chapter placed or erected for the regulation of parking by authority of this chapter. Each parking meter space or zone installed shall indicate by proper legend the legal parking time established by the city and when operated shall at all times indicate the balance of legal parking time and, at the expiration of such period, shall indicate illegal or overtime parking.
 - Parking meter district means that area designated by ordinance which shall be subject to this chapter and includes those streets or parts of streets upon which parking meters are installed and in operation. A district may include one (1) or more time and rate zones.
 - Parking meter space means any space or zone so designated within a parking meter district, adjacent to a parking meter. More than one (1) motorcycle may be parked in a parking meter space, provided each such motorcycle is parked with the rear wheel no more than 18 inches from the curb and with the front of such motorcycle facing away from that curb. No motorcycle may share a parking meter space with a motor vehicle having more than two (2) wheels. No motorcycle shall extend beyond the limits of the parking space in violation of Section 114-640 of this chapter.
