## **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of collective bargaining agreement with American Federation of State County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) for the period July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2030.

## **SYNOPSIS:**

The current agreement with AFSCME expires June 30, 2025. The City has reached a voluntary settlement for a successor agreement for a period of five (5) years.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: The financial impact of the agreement is consistent with the proposed budget.

<u>Funding Source</u>: Wages are paid from the Municipal Housing Agency budget.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

AFSCME represents 25 full-time employees in the Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency working in jobs such as: Case Managers, Housing Inspectors, Housing Maintenance, Administrative Assistants and Accounting Analysts. Specific items in the agreement are:

- 1) Five (5)-year term.
- 2) Across-the-board wage adjustments of 3.00% effective July 1, 2025, and 2.75% effective July 1, 2026, with a wage reopener in Years 3, 4 and 5 of the agreement pursuant to state collective bargaining law.
- 3) Pay upgrade for Administrative Secretaries and Bookkeeper.
