## AGENDA HEADING:

Approving of traffic paint purchase from Ennis-Flint, Inc. per Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Contract No. 2024-8346.

## SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of traffic paint purchase from Ennis-Flint, Inc. (4161 Piedmont Parkway, Suite 370, Greensboro, NC 27410) per IDOT Contract No. 2024-8346.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Traffic and Transportation Division of the Engineering Department requested the Finance Department, Procurement Division, purchase traffic paint. Traffic paint was competitively bid by IDOT and is available from Ennis-Flint, Inc. per Iowa IDOT Contract No. 2024-8346. Municipal Code Section 2-726(k) provides for the purchase of goods or services from contracts established by the State of Iowa Department of General Services, IDOT, and the Iowa Communications Network, pursuant to procedures established by Chapter 8A Code of Iowa rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Purchasing Division.
- The traffic paint is used during the application of striping and demarcation of roadway lanes, bike lanes, crosswalks, etc. to provide visual guidance to motorists and pedestrians to improve safety.
