Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

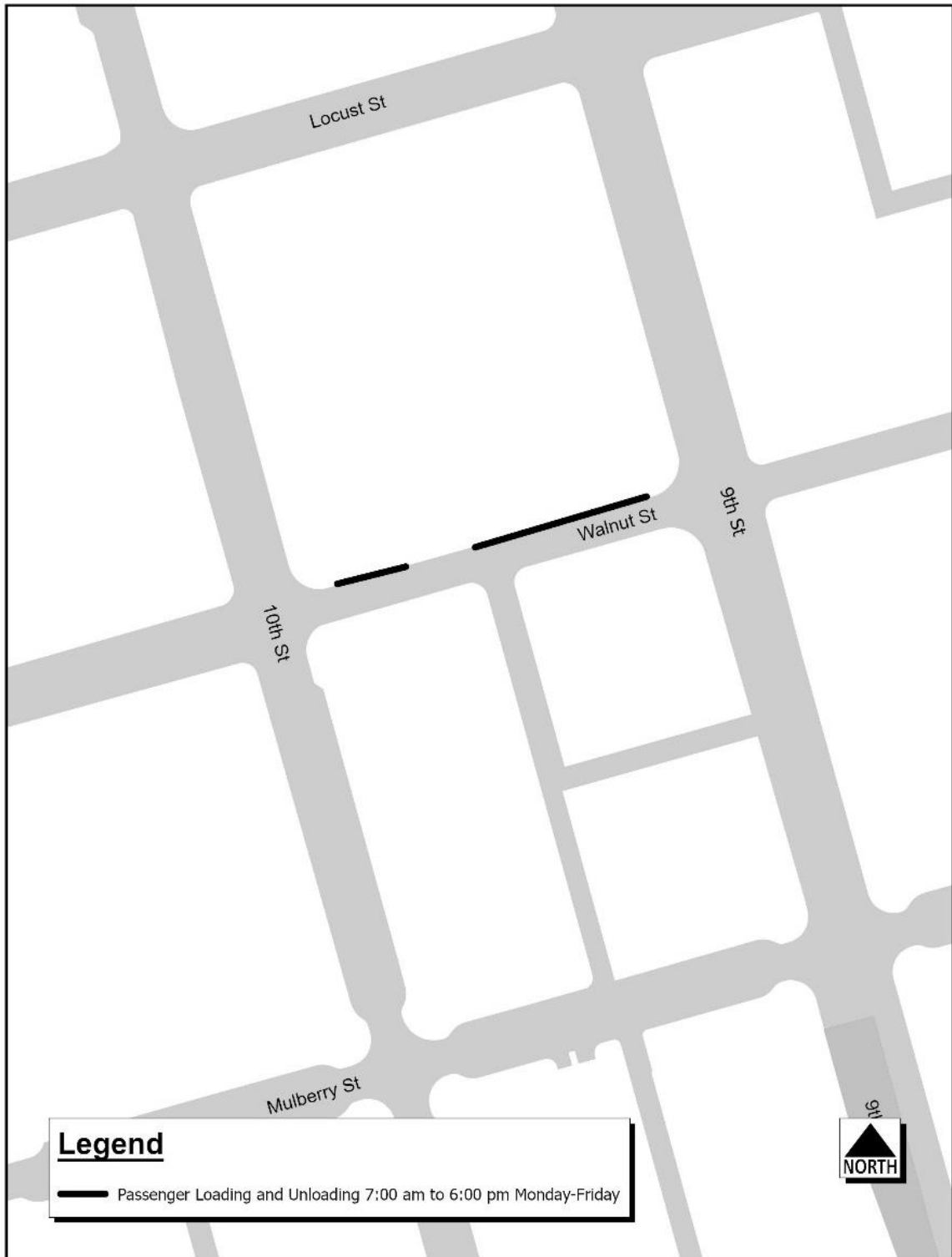

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. City Staff have met with the Walnut Street School Staff to discuss pick-up/drop-off operations around the school. The school has concerns with cars parking in the existing bus loading area on Walnut Street during school hours and during the summer school program. Based on these discussions, it was determined that parking and bus loading adjacent to the school on Walnut Street should be converted to passenger loading to meet the school’s current usage and needs. The following revisions to the Municipal Code are necessary to put the recommended changes into effect.



Sec. 114-3740. Walnut Street--Ninth Street to Tenth Street.

Walnut Street, on the north side, from Ninth Street to Tenth Street, school bus loading and unloading 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. school days. passenger loading and unloading, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, 20 minutes only.
