AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2025 Citywide Pavement Marking Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Quality Striping, Inc. (Jamie Jirak, President), \$647,184.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2025 Citywide Pavement Marking Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for placement of pavement markings at the locations shown on the map below, and other locations as directed by the City Engineer.

FISCAL IMPACT:


Amount: \$647,184 Construction Contract (\$620,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2025 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page 105, Roadway Reconstruction, ST260, Being: \$197,184 in Road Use Tax Funds and the remaining \$450,000 in Road Use Tax Funds transferred from EG062080 (T&T - Sign, Painting, Signal and Lighting)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On March 10, 2025, under Roll Call No. 25-0325, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2025 Citywide Pavement Marking Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2025 Citywide Pavement Marking Program, Activity ID 04-2025-004. The improvement includes installing pavement markings, traffic control and other incidental items, all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File No. 673-291/315 at the following locations and other locations directed by the City Engineer:
 - o Ingersoll Avenue from 42nd Street to Polk Boulevard
 - O Urbandale Avenue from 34th Street to Beaver Avenue
 - Crosswalks and stop bars on Grand Avenue from 6th Avenue to 14th Street

- o Crosswalks and stop bars at the intersection of 6th Avenue and Hickman Road
- o Mid-block Continental Crosswalks at various locations in the City
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - o Quality Striping, Inc., Des Moines, IA Low Bid
 - o Iowa Plains Signing, Inc., Slater, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, IA at 11:00 a.m. on March 25, 2025.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Quality Striping, Inc. (Jamie Jirak, President, 1704 E. Euclid Avenue, Des Moines, IA 50313) in the amount of \$647,184, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in spring 2025 and be completed by fall 2026.
