AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Beaverdale Park – Stream Enhancement and Stabilization: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as TK Grading & Seeding LLC (Tyler Knudsen, Owner) \$98,306.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Beaverdale Park – Stream Enhancement and Stabilization and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will improve the northeast portion of Beaverdale Park with stream enhancement and bank stabilization with excavation and installation of rip rap.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On March 10, 2025, under Roll Call No. 25-0329, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Beaverdale Park Stream Enhancement and Stabilization. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Beaverdale Park Stream Enhancement and Stabilization, Activity ID 11-2024-002. The improvement includes stream enhancement and stabilization south of Red Cross Drive and west of 30th Street by excavation, rip rap, stabilization, and other incidental items, all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File No. 661-170/183, located in Beaverdale Park at 3333 Adams Avenue.

- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, IA at 11:00 a.m. on March 25, 2025.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by TK Grading & Seeding LLC (Tyler Knudsen, Owner; 421 W Broadway, Suite 302 #161, Council Bluffs, IA 51503) in the amount of \$98,306, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- An environmental engineering consultant has developed plans to improve the ecological resilience of Beaverdale Park.
- This project is anticipated to commence construction this spring/summer and be completed in the fall of 2025.
