AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2025 Riverwalk Improvements – Balustrade Replacement: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Minturn, Inc., Clinton M. Rhoads, President, \$232,375.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2025 Riverwalk Improvements – Balustrade Replacement and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project replaces deteriorated portions of the balustrade wall with a cast stone balustrade wall along the west side of the Des Moines River between Center Street and Locust Street and between Walnut Street and Court Avenue. The replacement sections of the balustrade wall will replicate the design of the existing wall.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On June 9, 2025, under Roll Call No. 25-0803, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2025 Riverwalk Improvements – Balustrade Replacement. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2025 Riverwalk Improvements – Balustrade Replacement, Activity ID 11-2025-005. The improvement includes removal of existing sections of balustrade wall and replacement with sections of cast stone balustrade wall, all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File No. 674-116/125, located along the west side of the Des Moines River between Center Street and Locust Street and between Walnut Street and Court Avenue.

- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, IA, at 11:00 a.m. on June 24, 2025.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Minturn, Inc. 9 (Clinton M. Rhoads, President; 144 W. Front Street, PO Box 369, Brooklyn, IA 52211) in the amount of \$232,375, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in summer 2025 and be completed in summer 2026.
- The contractor will need to close portions of the Principal Riverwalk trail Monday through Friday for up to four (4) weeks; however, the contractor is required to reopen the trail on Saturdays and Sundays during those weeks.
