AGENDA HEADING:

Resolution approving the increase of the Microsoft Azure BLOB storage using Omnia Partners Contract No. 23-6692-03 through City Contract No. K24-449 between the City and Insight Public Sector, Inc. (Joyce Mullen, President and CEO; 910 W. Carver Road, Tempe, AZ 85284) to an estimated annual amount of \$96,000 (\$8,000 monthly) pursuant to the Microsoft Enterprise Enrollment Agreement.

SYNOPSIS:

With the expansion of the City's data centers and the increased data storage use by public safety, the City is exceeding its current limit of \$72,000 annually (\$6,000 monthly) for Azure BLOB storage, which is our cloud-based, off-site, long-term data backup solution. We are currently paying overages every month and based upon current and projected usage trends, would like to expand the annual amount to \$96,000 (\$8,000 monthly), which is greater than a 20% increase annually.
