 - 1. E 1st Street E Court Avenue to E Walnut Street
 - 2. E 2nd Street E Court Avenue to E Walnut Street

Amount: Costs for sign installations and periodic maintenance of signs.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

A. The offices of the United States District Court as well as other agencies of the US Federal Government have moved from buildings located at 123 E Walnut Street and 218 E 2nd Street. As a result, the designation of curb spaces to reserve spaces for United States Attorney, United States Marshal and Department of the Treasury officials are no longer needed along E 1st and E 2nd Streets. The building located at 218 E 2nd Street is being remodeled for new tenants and uses, and its exterior site plan has yet to be finalized.

It is recommended that metered parking be added both to the east curb of E 1st Street and along the northern portion of the west curb of E 2nd Street between E Court Avenue and E Walnut Street. The southern portion of the west curb of E 2nd Street between E Court Avenue and E Walnut Street will be designated as No Parking Anytime until the site plan for 218 E 2nd Street is finalized and implemented.

The following modifications to the Municipal Code will place these changes into effect.



Sec. 114-2580. East First Street—East Court Avenue to East Walnut Street.

East First Street, on the east side, from East Court Avenue to a point 55 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

East First Street, on the east side, from a point 55 feet north of East Court Avenue to a point 145 feet south of East Walnut Street, reserved for United States Marshal officials.

East First Street, on the east side, from East Walnut Street to a point 55 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

East First Street, on the east side, from a point 55 feet south of East Walnut Street to a point 65 feet south thereof, reserved for Department of the Treasury officials.

East First Street, on the east side, from a point 120 feet south of East Walnut Street to a point 25 feet south thereof, reserved for United States Attorney.

Sec. 114-2596. - East Second Street—East Court Avenue to East Walnut Street.

East Second Street, on the west side, from East Court Avenue to <u>205 feet north thereof, no</u> parking any time <u>East Walnut Street</u>, reserved for <u>United States Marshal officials</u>.
