AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of three (3) replacement single axle dump trucks for use in the Streets Division of the Public Works Department.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommended approval to purchase three (3) Mack 64BR single axle dump trucks for use in the Streets Division of the Public Works Department. utilizing Sourcewell Contract No. 032824-MAK from Housby Mack (8700 SE Convenience Blvd., Ankeny, IA 50021; Kelly Housby, CEO) in the amount of \$463,425.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$463,425

Funding Source: Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026 Recommended Operating Budget, Page 78, Equipment Replacement Fund

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The requested single axle dump trucks will replace three (3) existing International trucks purchased in 2012 that have reached the end of their useful service. The three (3) vehicles being replaced had an average annual maintenance and repair cost of nearly \$20,000 from calendar year 2021 to calendar year 2024. These costs are projected to increase as the vehicle age increases, which also contributes to vehicle downtime due to unscheduled maintenance demands.
- The Streets Division will use the requested Mack trucks for emergency snow and ice control operations, street repairs, and year-round scheduled operations.
