#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

From the inception of the Growing Futures program in 2019, TreesForever has planted 9,752 trees, while employing 300 students, engaging 3,341 volunteers who provided 9,100 volunteer hours. Each year 60 teenage students will be employed, planting 1000-1500 trees through the spring and fall planting season. This contribution has had a lasting impact on our urban canopy, and the residents living within.
