AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of three (3) replacement Labrie rear load solid waste trucks for use in the Sanitation Division of the Public Works Department.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommended approval to purchase three (3) replacement Labrie rear load solid waste trucks for use in the Sanitation Division of the Public Works Department.

The three (3) recommended Mack chassis purchases utilize Sourcewell Contract No. 032824-MAK from Housby Mack (8700 SE Convenience Blvd, Ankeny, IA 50021; Kelly Housby, CEO) in the amount of \$587,094.

The three (3) recommended Mack chassis will be upfitted with Labrie bodies utilizing 110223-LEG from Kilburg Equipment (431 West Grant Street, Preston, IA 52069; Jesse Kilburg, Owner) in the amount of \$401,192.40.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The three (3) requested rear load solid waste trucks will replace three (3) existing Mack rear load solid waste truck purchased in 2017. The vehicles being replaced meet current replacement guidelines and were recommended for purchase during the annual vehicle acquisition review. The existing vehicles had an average annual maintenance and repair cost of nearly \$32,000 from calendar year 2022 to calendar year 2025.
