AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2026 Citywide Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) Pavement Patching Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Brothers Cleaning Corporation d/b/a Brothers Concrete, Josecito Valero, President, \$1,504,772.63.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2026 Citywide PCC Pavement Patching Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for maintenance of PCC streets, utilizing full-depth removal and replacement of distressed concrete panels in select locations to extend the useful life of the streets.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On January 26, 2026, under Roll Call No. 26-0091, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2026 Citywide PCC Pavement Patching Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2026 Citywide PCC Pavement Patching Program, Activity ID 06-2026-004. The improvement includes removals, drilling and doweling, furnishing, placing, curing, sawing, sealing PCC pavement full-depth patches of various thickness, and other incidental items, all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File No. 679-054/095 at the following locations:
 - East 39th Street from East Sheridan Avenue to Hull Avenue
 - Southwest 7th Street from Payton Avenue to Porter Avenue
 - East Emma Avenue from South Union Street to Southeast 3rd Street
 - East Diehl Avenue from South Union Street to Southeast 5th Street

- Southeast 25th Court from Vale Street to Onawa Street
 - Lyon Street from East 6th Street to Pennsylvania Avenue
 - Brook Ridge Court from Brook View Avenue to East Douglas Avenue
 - East 26th Street from Maple Street to University Avenue
 - Southwest 6th Street from McKinley Avenue to Emma Avenue
 - Park Plaza Drive from Willowmere Drive to Park Avenue
 - East 41st Street from Boyd Street to Morton Avenue
 - East Madison Avenue from East 14th Street to East 16th Street
 - Summit Vista Drive from Southwest 31st Street to dead end west
 - East Park Avenue from Southeast 14th Street to Southeast 17th Street
 - South Union Street from McKinley Avenue to Park Avenue
 - Dixon Street from South Entrance of 1800 Dixon Street to Thompson Avenue
 - East Washington Avenue from East 17th Street to Dixon Street.
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - Brothers Cleaning Corporation d/b/a Brothers Concrete, Des Moines, IA - Low Bid
 - HS Concrete, Inc., Des Moines, IA
 - The Concrete Contracting Company, Inc., Grimes, IA
 - Howser Concrete Unlimited, LLC, Urbandale, IA
 - MPS Engineers, P.C. dba Kingston Services, P.C., Des Moines, IA
 - TK Concrete, Inc., Pella, IA
 - Iowa Civil Contracting, Inc., Victor, IA
 - The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 1st Floor, T.M. Franklin Cownie City Administration Building, 1200 Locust Street, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on February 10, 2026.
 - The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Brothers Cleaning Corporation d/b/a Brothers Concrete (4000 Colfax Avenue, Des Moines, IA, 50317; Josecito Valero, President), in the amount of \$1,504,772.63, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
 - Construction of this project is anticipated to be completed by fall of 2027 and in accordance with various completion provisions, including the following:
 - Construction work on South Union Street from McKinley Avenue to Park Avenue shall be completed in the summer of 2026 while school is out of session.
 - Construction work on the East 26th Street and East Park Avenue locations shall be completed in either the summer of 2026 or the summer of 2027 while school is out of session.
