## AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the Iowa Department of Natural Resources Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) Urban Forestry Development Grant application for urban forestry initiatives in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

## SYNOPSIS:

The Public Works Department – Forestry Division seeks authorization to submit an application to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) for the Urban Forestry Development Grant, funded through the USDA Forest Service’s IRA, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

The Urban Forestry Development Grant is a competitive, reimbursable, non-match grant program administered by IDNR to support eligible urban forestry initiatives. The two-year program (2026–2027) allows for projects such as community forestry planning, City tree ordinance development or revision, workforce development, educational programming, and other related urban forestry efforts.

If awarded, funding would support priority urban forestry initiatives within the City of Des Moines consistent with City canopy goals, sustainability objectives, and long-term tree management strategies.
