## AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding Traffic Regulation Changes as follows:

- A. Parking Modification – SW 33rd Street south of Gannett Avenue

## SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes. Costs for sign installations and periodic maintenance of signs.

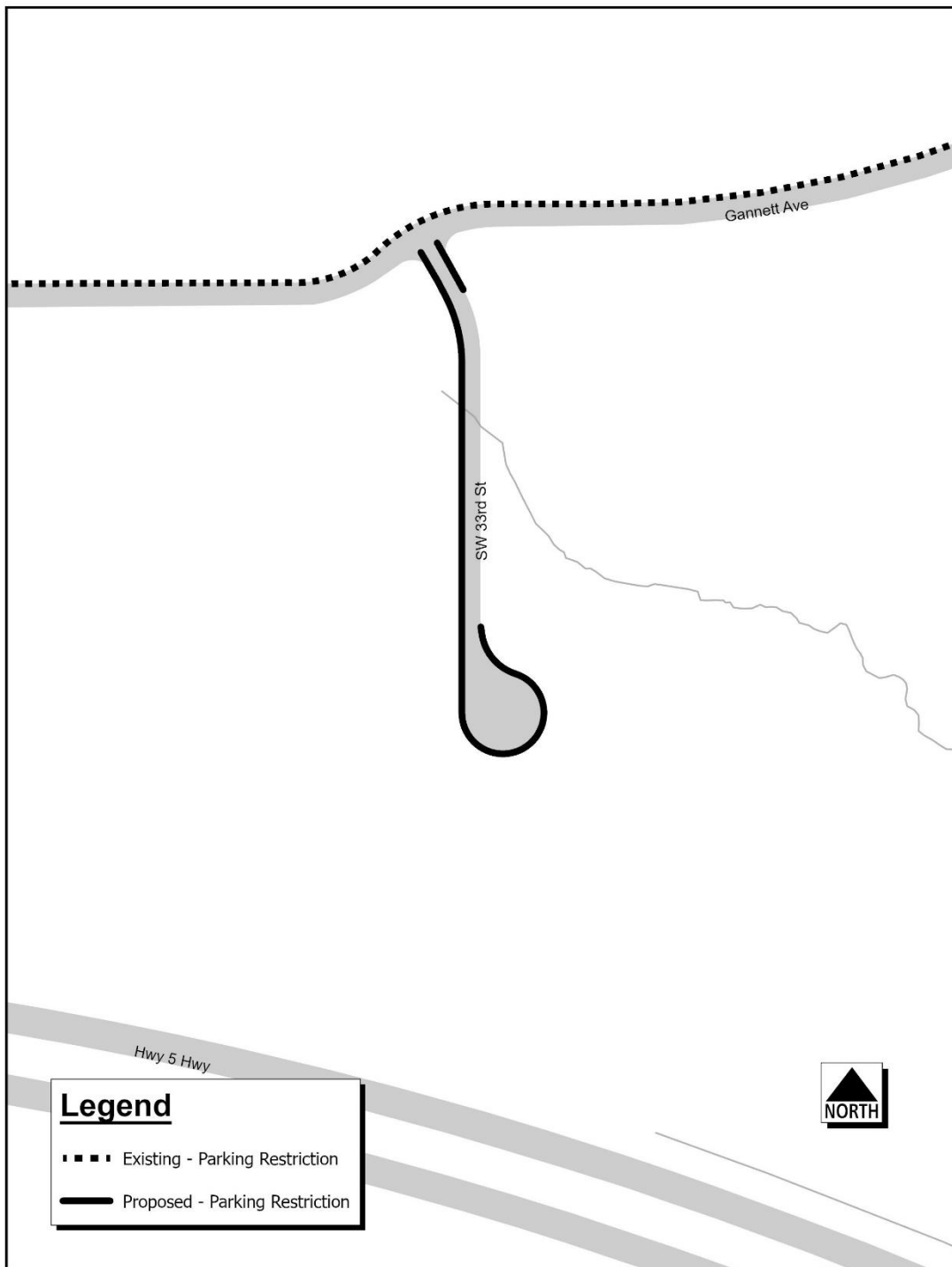

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. Engineering staff received a concern that semi-trucks are parking on both sides of SW 33rd Street south of Gannett Avenue and within the dead end to the south. SW 33rd Street is a 25-foot wide street. Per the City's Parking Restriction Policy, parking should be restricted on one side of streets of this width. Staff propose restricting parking on the west side of SW 33rd Street south of Gannett Avenue and within the cul-de-sac at the dead end. A corner clearance would also be placed on the east side of SW 33rd Street at the intersection with Gannett Avenue to facilitate turning movements. The following modifications to the Municipal Code will place these changes into effect.



Sec. 114-2883. Southwest Thirty-third Street--Park Avenue to cul-de-sac south of ~~Stanton Avenue.~~ Gannett Avenue.

~~Southwest Thirty third Street, on the west side, from Park Avenue to a point 550 feet south of Wolcott Avenue and any part of the cul-de-sac, no parking any time.~~

~~Southwest Thirty third Street, on the west side, from Stanton Avenue to a point 460 feet north of Stanton Avenue and any part of the cul-de-sac, no parking any time.~~

~~Southwest Thirty-third Street, on the west side, from Stanton Avenue to a point 570 feet south of Stanton Avenue and any part of the cul-de-sac, no parking any time.~~

Southwest Thirty-third Street, on the west side, from Park Avenue to and including the cul-de-sac south of Wolcott Avenue, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirty-third Street, on the west side, from and including the cul-de-sac north of Stanton Avenue to and including the cul-de-sac south of Stanton Avenue, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirty-third Street, on the west side, from Gannett Avenue to and including the cul-de-sac south of Gannett Avenue, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirty-third Street, on the east side, from Gannett Ave to a point 70 feet south thereof, no parking anytime.
