## AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Downtown Skywalk Signage Replacement - Receiving bids, (5-5-2026), and Setting date of hearing, (6-8-2026). (Construction Estimate - \$550,000).

## SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. Replacement of overhead and wall-mounted wayfinding signage located within the downtown skywalk system.

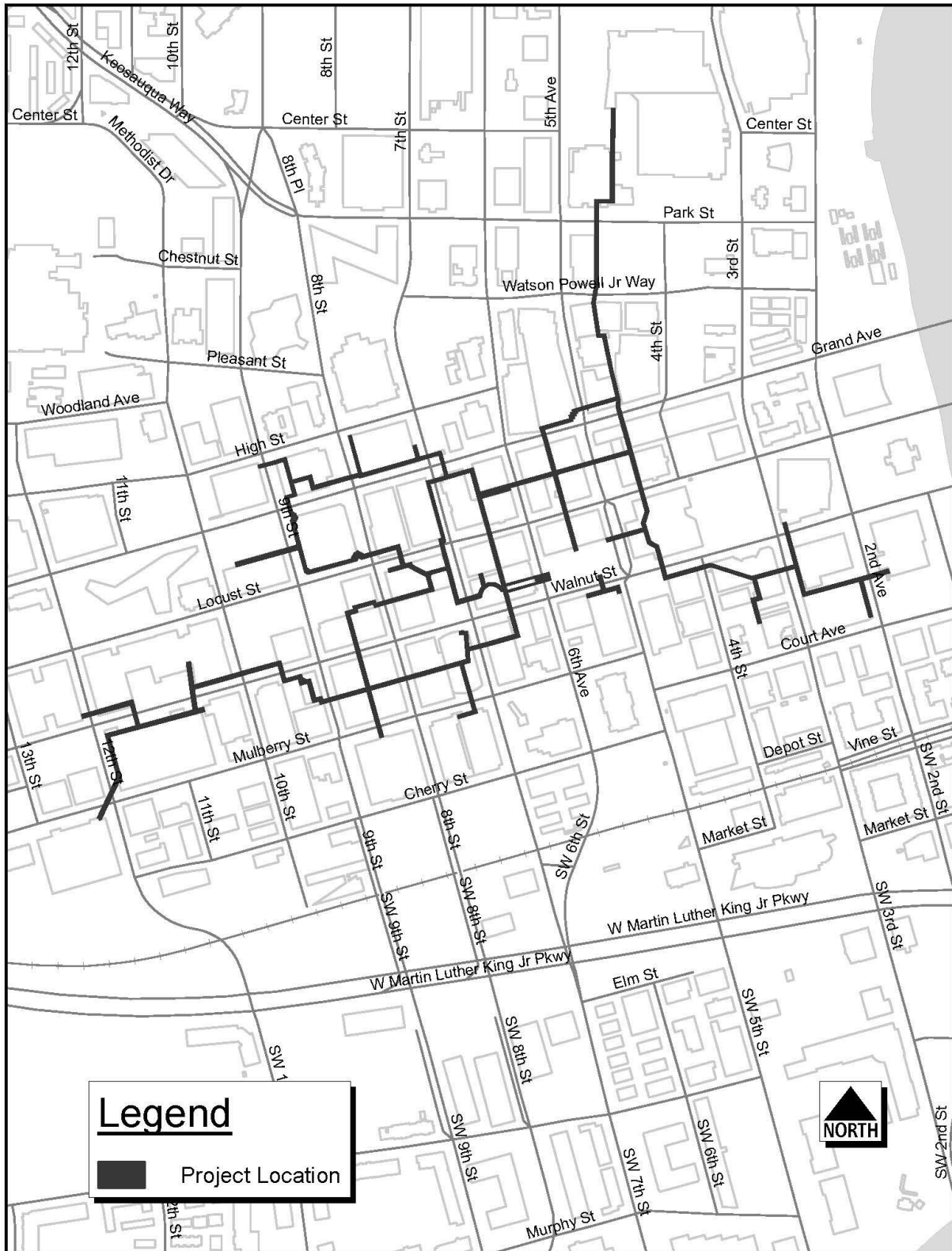

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- In late 2023, the City contracted with RDG Planning & Design (RDG) to complete design for Skywalk Wayfinding Improvements. As part of the design process, a Wayfinding Masterplan was developed in coordination with a Project Leaders and Stakeholders group comprised of representatives from the City of Des Moines, the Greater Des Moines Partnership, Catch DSM and the Downtown Neighborhood Association.
- The Wayfinding Master Plan, March 25, 2026, was comprised of several components including discussion on Skywalk Branding, Community Engagement, Nomenclature and Prioritization, Signage Standards and Specifications, Project Phasing, Replacement Destinations, Wayfinding Exhibits and Cost Estimates.
- Community Engagement consisted of Online Surveys, Stakeholder Listening Sessions, Kiosk Accessibility Testing and Collaborative Feedback.
- Key Audiences engaged throughout the process included Iowa Department for the Blind, Des Moines Access Advisory Board, Central Iowa Shelter & Services, Des Moines Civil and Human Rights Commission, Des Moines Public Library, Downtown Neighborhood Association, Des Moines Area Regional Transit (DART), Des Moines Street Collective, Fleet

Feet Running Club, Downtown YMCA, as well as the surveying of the public during downtown events and via Catch DSM promotions.

- Based on feedback that was received, RDG developed design plans for the replacement of signage and equipment throughout the Skywalk system.
- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Downtown Skywalk Signage Replacement, Activity ID 04-2026-017. The improvement includes the installation of overhead and wall-mounted static directional/wayfinding signage throughout the downtown skywalk system, and other areas as directed by the City Engineer, all in accordance with the contract documents located throughout all skywalks, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$550,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are currently available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office and will be available as of April 21, 2026 through the City's electronic bid submission system at <https://www.bidexpress.com/businesses/27010/home>.
- This project is anticipated to begin in summer of 2026 and be completed in winter of 2026.
