AGENDA HEADING:

First consideration to amend Chapter 26 of the Municipal Code – Buildings and Building Regulations

SYNOPSIS:

Approval of this action amends Chapter 26 of the Municipal Code with following actions:

- Requires a re-roofing permit for both commercial and residential structures beginning on January 1, 2027.
- Modifies the electrical code to comply with recent legislative changes to the State Electrical Code.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Estimated at \$150,000

Funding Source: Permit fees from re-roofing projects for residential and commercial structures.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The second and third reading is requested to be waived due to the editorial nature of these code changes.
- The City of Des Moines Building and Fire Code Board of Appeals has reviewed and recommends adoption of these changes to Chapter 26.
