AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Amendments to the Schedule of Fees Regarding Chapter 61 as it relates to the Property Maintenance Code and Vacant Property Registry.

SYNOPSIS:

The purpose of the proposed amendment to the Schedule of Fees is to reflect the changes to the organization of Chapter 61 and the new section numbers assigned to the various provisions that reference the Schedule of Fees and to adequately define the enforcement and registration fees referenced in Chapter 6.
