AGENDA HEADING:

Hold public hearing on the proposed 1st Amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Carpenter Urban Renewal Area.

SYNOPSIS:

This roll call opens and closes the public hearing on the proposed 1st Amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Carpenter Urban Renewal Area. This Amendment updates Appendix B – Financial Condition Report, and updates Appendix C – Economic Development and Redevelopment Activities. The required consultation was held on July 9, 2026, and no comments have been received.
