AGENDA HEADING:

Recommend approval for the purchase of Rapid7 Managed Threat Complete subscription for \$174,500 annually, for a period of up to five (5) years, from Insight Public Sector (Jack Azagury, President and CEO, 2701 E. Insight Way, Chandler, AZ 85286), using Omnia Contract 23-6692-03 and governed by terms and conditions of Short Form Agreement #K24-449.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for the purchase of Rapid7 Managed Threat Complete subscription for \$174,500 annually, for a period of up to five (5) years, from Insight Public Sector, 2701 E. Insight Way, Chandler, AZ 85286 (Jack Azagury, President and CEO); using Omnia Contract 23-6692-03 and governed by terms and conditions of Short Form Agreement #K24-449. Consolidation of security tools will expand capabilities using the Rapid7 platform. This renewal supersedes the existing Rapid7 annual subscription and replaces a significant portion of cybersecurity components under the Cisco Security Enterprise Agreement (EA).

- Annual Savings: \$21,958
 - Supersedes existing Rapid7 annual renewal: \$105,300
 - Consolidates annual cost of Endpoint Protection, Network analytics, and Malware Analytics components from Cisco EA to Rapid7: \$91,158

- Administered by the Information Technology (IT) Department's Security Team, the Rapid7 "Managed Threat Complete" suite of tools consolidates our existing Rapid7 subscription and related security products from the Cisco EA. In addition, this will provide 24/7 detection and response services and unlimited endpoint licensing which expands our threat assessment capabilities.
- Professional monitoring, response, and support services can respond to security incidents even when IT staff are unavailable and also aid in vulnerability remediation. Finally, consolidating products under a single platform creates efficiencies in computer performance and ease of forensic investigations and time-sensitive remediations.
