

ORDINANCE NO. 13,609

AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of a North/South alley in the vicinity of S.E. 28th and Maury Streets.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the following described portion of the North/South alley in the vicinity of S.E. 28th and Maury Streets be and is hereby vacated:

Except the North 25.0 feet as measured on the West line, all that part of the 10.0 foot North/South alley right-of-way lying East of and adjoining Lots 1 through 11, Block 20, LARISON PLACE, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. That this vacation is made with reservations of right-of-way easements for any public utilities now in place with the right of entry for servicing same.

Sec. 3. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
