

ORDINANCE NO. 13,665

AN ORDINANCE vacating all the alley rights-of-way in the block bounded by S.E. 8th, S.E. 9th and Vale Streets and by Railroad Avenue.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public rights-of-way herein described be vacated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That all the alley rights-of-way in the block bounded by S.E. 8th, S.E. 9th and Vale Streets and by Railroad Avenue, more specifically described as follows, be and are hereby vacated:

All the East/West alley right-of-way lying North of and adjoining Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, Block 71, Town of De Moine, an Official Plat; and all the North/South alley right-of-way lying West of and adjoining Lots 7 and 8, in said Block 71, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. That this vacation is made with reservations of right-of-way easements for any public utilities now in place with the right of entry for servicing same.

Sec. 3. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
