

ORDINANCE NO. 14,065

AN ORDINANCE vacating the North/South alley between 3rd and 4th Streets extending between Corning and New York Avenues.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the North/South alley between 3rd and 4th Streets extending between Corning and New York Avenues more specifically described as follows, be and is hereby vacated:

All of North/South alley right-of-way lying East of and adjoining Lots 102 through 110, Block 4, Lake Park, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. That this vacation is made with reservations of right-of-way easements for any public utilities now in place with the right of entry for servicing same.

Sec. 3. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 4. This ordinance reaffirms and ratifies the action taken under Ordinance No. 14,054, which was inadvertently passed February 18, 2002, prior to the required public hearing on the proposed vacation.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
