- AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, by adding and enacting a new Section 114-107 thereof, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations regarding railroad crossings.
- Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, is hereby amended by adding and enacting a new Section 114-107 relating to traffic and vehicle regulations regarding railroad crossings, as follows:

Sec. 114-107. Park Avenue crossing in vicinity of 5200 Park Avenue.

In order to promote the public safety and general welfare, Monarch Cement of Iowa, Inc. is ordered to erect, maintain and operate suitable mechanical signal devices at the intersection of the tracks of the railroad on Park Avenue in the city. Monarch Cement of Iowa, Inc. is also ordered to construct and repair all street surface between the rails of their tracks, and one foot outside, at their own expense, in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Section 364.11.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law. FORM APPROVED:
