

ORDINANCE NO. 15,252

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Section 70-84(b)(4), relating to hunting permit application fees.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Section 70-84(b)(4) relating to hunting permits, as follows:

Sec. 70-84. Hunting.

(b) Licensed bow hunters meeting the requirements established by the state department of natural resources (DNR) may hunt antlerless deer within the areas designated as the "Des Moines Special Deer Management Zones" on public or private property, under all the following conditions:

- (4) Hunters must have a permit issued by the director of the park and recreation department and comply with the terms and conditions of such permit. A permit application fee of \$10 shall be paid by hunters to the park and recreation department from August 1-31. The application fee shall be \$20 for applications received after August 31st during the current deer hunting season.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
