

ORDINANCE NO. 15,619

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 42-212 and by repealing Section 42-214, relating to prohibitions of fireworks.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Section 42-212 and by repealing Section 42-214, relating to prohibitions of fireworks, as follows:

Sec. 46-212. Prohibitions.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to manufacture Fireworks within the city limits.
- (b) It shall be unlawful to sell Display Fireworks within the city limits.
- (c) It shall be unlawful for a person to possess, use or explode Display Fireworks except in possession of and in compliance with all requirements of a permit issued under Section 46-215.
- (d) It shall be unlawful for a person to use or explode Consumer Fireworks within the city limits.

Sec. 46-214. Repealed by Ord. No. 15,619.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
