PROPOSED DRAFT OF TICKET ORDINANCE

Sec. ___ Prohibition Against Resale of Tickets for Admission to a Place of Entertainment

- (a) "Place of Entertainment" shall include the following designated locations: Civic Center of Greater Des Moines; Des Moines Area Community College Auditorium; The Des Moines Playhouse; Drake Knapp Center; Drake Sheslow Auditorium; Drake Stadium; Hoyt Sherman Place; Iowa State Fair Grandstand; Principal Park; Science Center of Iowa; Temple for Performing Arts; Wells Fargo Arena; Veterans Memorial Auditorium; or similar venues where the anticipated crowd is approximately 200 persons or more provided however that a "Place of Entertainment" shall not include public or private secondary schools.
- (b) Tickets for admission to a place of entertainment may not be offered for resale within 500 feet of the physical structure where the ticket will be used. This prohibition shall also apply to attempted resales to occupants of vehicles and shall be in effect regardless of whether the person attempting to sell the ticket is doing so on public or private property.
- (c) Any person who commits an act prohibited by this section shall be guilty of a simple misdemeanor punishable by a fine of no less than \$65 and no more than \$500.
