This office represents 3101 Ingersoll, L.L.C. (hereinafter the "Owner"), which owns the properties locally known as 3101 Ingersoll Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50312 and 608 31st Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50312.

The Owner received a Notice of Petition and Public Hearing, dated December 19, 2006, regarding the establishment of the proposed Ingersoll Avenue Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District (the "SSMID"). The Owner hereby respectfully objects to the establishment of the proposed SSMID. Although the proposed improvements may enhance the aesthetics of the proposed improvement district, the Owner believes that an increase in taxes as a result of the SSMID will actually discourage further economic development along the Ingersoll Avenue corridor.
